

## **Pro Bono Immigration Attorney**

### *Candidate Profile:*

- Immigration Attorney in good standing
- Willingness to interact with limited English clients

### *Position Description:*

The International Institute of MN (IIM) is recognized by the Board of Immigration Appeals to provide immigration related services. The Pro Bono Attorney would provide assistance with these services.

### *Primary Duties Include:*

- Meet with citizenship and permanent residency applicants to complete the necessary immigration application.
- Provide pro-bono consultation and mentorship to the partially accredited representative in the area of immigration law.
- Consult and review a limited number of cases with the accredited representative, mainly in regards to permanent residency and citizenship.
- Respond to general questions from the accredited representative about various areas of immigration law such as immediate relative petition.
- Support accredited representative in renewal of accreditation.

### *Time Commitment:*

- Ability to commit for four months.
- Ability to volunteer at least 3 hours per week (Mon. – Fri.; 9 a.m.-5 pm) to meet with clients AND / OR meet approximately once a month with accredited representative for case consultation
