Donor Privacy Policy

The International Institute of Minnesota (IIMN) is committed to protecting the privacy of all donors. We undertake security practices to protect and restrict information access on our website and our donor database. IIMN uses secure SSL encryption technology to accept online credit card donations. All donor records are kept in a password protected database on a secured VPN network.

IIMN collects donor information from contributions made in person, through U.S. mail, on its website, or shared by a donor selected third party (ex. Give MN, donor advised fund, or donor employer payroll contributions). IIMN retains the name, address, email address, phone number and donation amount for all donors. Donor information will not be sold or distributed to any organization outside IIMN.

IIMN publishes names of donors in its annual report and on its website to recognize donors for their contributions. Donors may request to be anonymous or to not be publicly acknowledged in printed materials, email notifications or any other communication if they so desire by selecting this option at time of donation, or by contacting the representative listed below.

IIMN sends periodic mail and emails (monthly e newsletter, annual reports, event invitations) to share organization news and invite supporters to IIMN events; donors can contact the Annual Giving Manager at the address, phone number, or email address below to update their contact information.
